Students will take two 3-credit college courses afterschool at NBHS through BCC: CAD101 and EGR102. These courses can be used towards a certificate or degree program upon BCC enrollment or acceptance or may transfer to another institution per their guidelines.

The college readiness class will take place in Spring 2018 during a regularly assigned class, to be determined, and will be administered through a partnership with NBHS and Connecting Activities featuring the Signal Success curriculum.

Students may participate in the paid internship after successful completion of the two BCC courses and the career readiness class. Students may work with businesses such as Siemens or Eversource, TBD. The internship is paid 140 hours over 7 weeks in Summer 2018.
