Our organization recognizes and values the sacrifices veterans have made for our country and we strive each day to give back to those who have given so much. This scholarship, awarded to three seniors, was created to help veteran families who have graduating high school seniors who would benefit from a helping hand.

Deserving students that meet the following guidelines may apply by May 22, 2020:

- (1) Student must be a son/daughter of a veteran, or currently enrolled in Junior ROTC;
- (2) Student must be a senior in high school;
- (3) Student must have maintained between a 2.5 & 4.0 GPA throughout his/her final two years of high school;
- (4) Student is planning to enroll full-time in a bachelor's degree program at an accredited higher education institution, or an advanced vocational/technical school (i.e. culinary school), in the Fall directly after graduating from high school;
- (5) Student must live in one of the following counties:
Barnstable, Bristol, Norfolk, or Plymouth.

Applications must be submitted to Heidrea for Heroes, Inc. by May 22, 2020.

Complete applications include:

- (1) Scholarship application form (hard copy or online)
- (2) A copy of parent's DD214 with an honorable discharge listed - *N/A if in Junior ROTC (need documentation of being in the Junior ROTC)*
- (3) **Two** recommendation letters: **one** from someone in a leadership role in your life (i.e. a coach, employer, or mentor) & **one** from a teacher
- (4) Proof of current GPA standing/transcript.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
