

2021 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

SCHOLARSHIPS

SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, students must be a graduating, high school senior who is pursuing higher education at a two- or four-year college program or technical school. You must reside in one of the following communities: Attleboro, Berkley, Dartmouth, Dighton, Fairhaven, Fall River, Foxborough, New Bedford, Seekonk, Somerset, Swansea, or Westport of Massachusetts or Cranston, Little Compton, or Tiverton of Rhode Island. Immediate family members of BayCoast employees or Board Members are not eligible to apply.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A completed application must include:

- 1. A completed application form.
- 2. An official school transcript. If the school will not provide this directly to you, it may be sent directly to BayCoast at the email address noted on this instruction form.
- 3. A copy of the acceptance letter from the college or technical school you will be attending in Fall of 2021 (if obtained).
- 4. One letter of recommendation from a current or former teacher.

DEADLINE

The deadline to apply is **April 2, 2021**. All completed applications must be emailed to community@baycoastbank.com. Applications must include all the information listed above to be considered.

Scholarship winners will be notified in late April. They will need to submit an acceptance letter from the college or technical school they will be attending in Fall of 2021 before receiving scholarship funds.
